

Contact your local fire department to do a walkthrough of your property and provide recommendations for a pre-plan. A qualified electrician should also evaluate your facility.

- Inside –

	<b>Electrical</b> - all electrical wire is encased in non-corrosive conduit, outlets are GFCI protected and extension cords are rated outdoor and for temporary use only
	Lighting - all light fixtures are encased in safety enclosures or LED lighting is used
	Appliances - all fans and heaters used are suitable for agriculture
	<b>Dangerous Supplies</b> - flammable liquids, fuels and combustion powered-equipment are not stored in the stable
	<b>Storage</b> - hay and bedding are stored in a separate building a practical distance from stable (note: a few days supply of hay/bedding can be stored in stable)
	Alarms - smoke detectors/alarms are present and tested (batteries changed) as per manufacturer 's recommendations
	Site Plan - a floor and site plan is located on property and includes instructions on how to shut off the utilities (ensure everyone has knowledge of this)
	<b>Extinguishers</b> - 10 pound ABC fire extinguishers are mounted at each exit and everyone at the stable knows how to use one
	Housekeeping - regular clean-up and disposal of debris including cobwebs, hay and bedding
П	Clutter - aicles and doors are clear at all times





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Outside

Ш	both directions on the road (note: should also be posted inside stable)		
	Clear Driveway - driveway/road can accommodate fire department's vehicles - there are no overhanging branches and roadway is firm (i.e., gravel) and free of potholes		
	Winter Plan - daily snow/ice removal for driveway/road		
	Pre-Plan - has been completed with the local fire department		
	Clear Vegetation - all weeds, brush and debris have been cleared from around stable		
	Enforce No Smoking - "No Smoking" signs are posted around stable and boarders have been informed that smoking will not be tolerated anywhere on the property	—NOTES—	
	<b>Parking</b> - owned and tenanted vehicles are parked in designated area away from the stable		
	Access to Water - clearly marked, easy-to-access water spigots are located on exterior all sides of my stable		
	Garbage - rubbish and debris is regularly disposed of from around the farm		
	<b>Lightning Rods</b> - are installed properly on farm buildings
